After assembly the trays are put in up to two layers in the original game box.


Ordinary PVA glue is required when assembling each tray.

Please make sure you dry-assemble each tray correctly before gluing it together.

#### Note:

FS-BTKU is a full print insert. This means that the orientation of the tray pieces is important as in some cases the print on each side of a piece is different. Most trays are very straight-forward as to which way round each piece should go, but in order to prevent possible errors we strongly recommend checking our FS-BTKU product page on www.foldedspace.net so that you can see images of the fully assembled trays. In general, all the printed kodama spirits should be placed on the outside of the trays.

We always recommend dry-building the trays before adding glue, but for such full colour print designs this is even more important so that you can be sure everything is correct before gluing the tray pieces in place.
